§ 19-101. Permit Required. [Ord. 2006-6, 7/10/2006]

The erection and maintenance of any billboard or advertising sign permitted by the Smithfield Township Zoning Ordinance, Smithfield Township Code of Ordinances, Chapter 27, Part 5, § 27-517, shall require a permit, which permit may be obtained from the Smithfield Township office by completing an application for a sign permit and paying the required fee. No billboard or advertising sign may be erected or maintained without a permit.

§ 19-102. (Reserved)¹

§ 19-103. Violations and Penalties. [Ord. 2006-6, 7/10/2006]

Any person, partnership, corporation or other entity who or which has violated or permitted the violation of the provisions of this chapter, upon being found guilty thereof in a civil enforcement proceeding commenced by Smithfield Township, shall pay a fine of not more than \$600 plus court costs, including reasonable attorneys' fees incurred by the Township as a result of the prosecution of the violation. Each day that the violation continues shall constitute a separate violation. District Justices shall have initial jurisdiction over proceedings brought under this section.
